Just as a reminder, Mass begins with the sign of the Cross and ends with the final blessing. We should make the concerted effort to arrive before Mass begins and leave after the final blessing and procession. No part of the Mass is irrelevant and therefore we want to be present for its entirety. Of course, we understand that for an emergency or to look after a sick family member etc., we might arrive late or have to leave before the final blessing. Outside of such reasons we should be present for the entire Mass. ### CATECHESIS FOR CHILDREN

Commonly we offer some form of catechesis for adults in the form of book studies, bible studies, Catechism classes etc. It is ideal to offer such classes as it is good for all Catholic adults to strive to increase knowledge of the faith. Less commonly therefore, do we offer catechesis courses specifically for children. The primary reason for this is because religious education is something the Catholic schools try to provide. Yet, with a greater increase in homeschooling and possibly a lack of religious formation in the schools over the past couple of years due to Covid, I think this is an important topic to consider. **Therefore, I would like to offer catechism classes, for kids from Grades 2 to 5 on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday of the Month, at 6:30pm. Due to timing, the first class will begin October 27.** I am certainly open to discuss the 6:30pm time since I am uncertain the right time to offer classes for children. These classes will be dealing with the sacraments (especially first Holy Communion and Confession), and all the primary truths of our faith that is important for children to know.
