#### WORLD DAY OF THE POOR

The hope of the poor shall not perish for ever'
In his message for the fourth World Day of the Poor, celebrated on 15<sup>th</sup> November 2020, Pope Francis reminds us that "the poor are not numbers, but people", to be assisted, accompanied, protected, defended and saved. He recalled that this is not possible without the humility of listening, the charism of the whole, the courage of renunciation. He reminded us that to "follow the way of charity, of humility and of listening means lending an ear to the little ones", because God reveals himself through them. And he asked us not to look down on anyone from above. "You can only look down at a person from above," he insisted, "in order to help them get up".
